This expenditure is justified as:

- An emergency involving public health.
- An emergency involving public safety.
- Necessary to protect State property from further loss or damage.
- Necessary to prevent or minimize serious disruption in State services.
- Necessary to insure integrity of State records.
- Quick purchase as provided by Section 20-30 (d) of the Illinois Procurement Code.

The conditions and circumstances requiring this emergency expenditure are:

The flooding of the Mississippi river basin. Caused the overtopping of the US 136 roadway approach to the Mississippi river bridge between Hamilton, IL and Keokuk, Iowa. This expenditure is for furnishing labor and material to construct a temporary roadway to keep US 136 open to traffic. The work included furnishing of materials (i.e. various rock, crushed stone) for delivery and placement on US 136.

The vendor was selected based on availability of equipment, materials and personnel for immediate response.
