I, George F. Ryan being duly sworn, solemnly swear and affirm that I am Regional Engineer.

I have authorized the expenditure of funds for an emergency in accordance with standards set by rule and in fulfillment of the emergency purchase affidavit provisions of Illinois Procurement Code [30 ILCS 500/20-30] as follows.

- Involving threat to public health or public safety.
- Immediate expenditure is necessary for repairs to State property to protect against further loss of or damage
- To prevent or minimize serious disruption in critical State services that affect health, safety, or collection of substantial State revenues.
- To insure integrity of State records
- Quick purchase as provided by Section 20-30 (d) of the Illinois Procurement Code

The conditions and circumstances requiring this emergency purchase, including reason for selection of the particular contractor are:
The culvert under IL 172, approximately 1/2 mile south of Tampico, has collapsed. This has resulted in a subsequent pavement failure. To protect the traveling public, the District has closed the road. The anticipated repair of the roadway will require the removal and replacement of the damaged culvert pipe. Due to the sandy soil conditions and the elevation of the existing culvert, the contractor will either be required to utilize a protective cage to protect the workers from the collapse of the trench or to remove a sufficient amount of embankment to ensure the proper slope ratio.
