witness from Landrum & Brown with the requisite knowledge to testify concerning the reports  
issued by Landrum & Brown and one witness from RWDI with the requisite knowledge to testify  
concerning the reports issued by RWDI.

3. The motion to issue a subpoena to Northwestern Memorial Hospital which was  
sent to Judge Neville on June 22, 2009 is denied because there is no indication the Northwestern  
Memorial Hospital will present testimony at the public hearing.
