I have two comments on the proposed helicopter pad at Children's Memorial Hospital, and I am writing as a resident of the neighborhood and as someone who works in commercial aviation.

First, I believe the need for medical helicopter services should be considered comprehensively, and include neighboring hospitals and the area's emergency services. The proposal as stated limits use of the helicopter pad to patients of Children's Memorial. I would hope that if air evacuation is necessary for a patient in the surrounding hospitals or some emergency service that it would be available.

Second, there are weather events in the neighborhood during which operation of a helicopter would not be safe, as is the case with any location. Most aviation "accidents" that I am familiar with involve operating an aircraft outside its envelope, whether its weather, maintenance, etc.. The focus of the review should not be on establishing whether wind patterns are acceptable, but what processes does the operator have in place to assure its safe operation.
